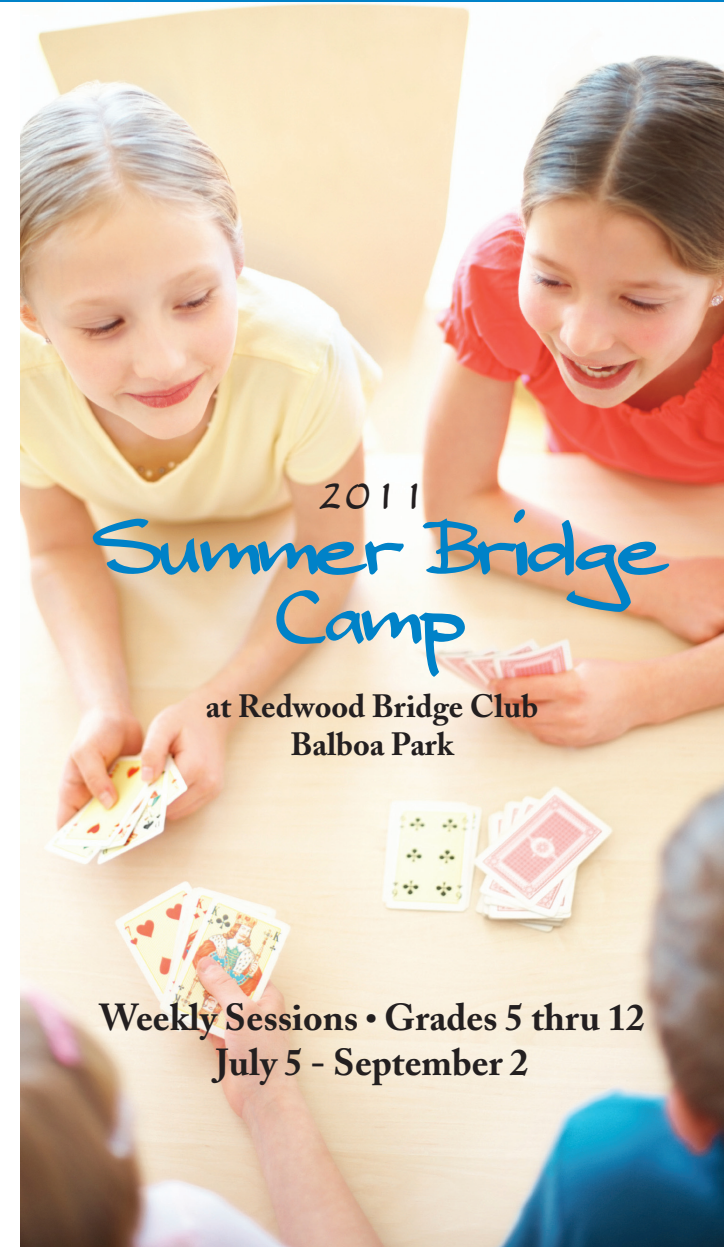

- \* Subsequent (optional) one-week, follow-on sessions are tailored to student skill and affinity levels.
